

Library Rules

Borrow

You need a library card if you want to borrow books or other media from the library. It is free to get a library card and to borrow items from the library. You need to show a photo identification in order to get a library card. Your name will be registered in the library's data system.

PIN-code

You will choose a personal PIN-code for you library card, which you need in order to borrow from the library.

Check out times

The check out times are usually four weeks. Sometimes the check out time can be shorter. If no one has reserved the item you have borrowed, you can extend the loan. If you return your item(s) too late, you must pay a fine.

Reserve a book

You can reserve a book that is already borrowed by someone else. When the book is returned, you will receive a message from us.

Interlibrary loan – borrow from other libraries

It is possible to borrow books from other libraries. Just ask your librarian and they will help you.

What if I lose my library card?

If your library card was lost or stolen, please contact us as soon as possible to report it. We will block your card so no one can use it until you are able to come in with a valid form of photo ID and get a replacement.
